

The FIL Women's Lacrosse World Cup will be hosted at Surrey Sports Park in Guildford, England between July 13th and 22nd, 2017. In 2013, Team USA defeated Canada 19-5 to win the gold medal.

DAY 1 Monday, 10 July 2017

Relax and enjoy our scheduled flight from your major east coast to London.*

Tuesday, 11 July 2017

- Our 24-hour Tour Director will meet us at the airport and remain with us until our final airport departure.
- We will have use of a private coach and driver while in England. The bus will be available for all transfers, excursions and required sightseeing content.
- Visit Windsor Castle, the world's largest inhabited castle, and one of the official royal residences of the British monarch. Our visit will include the richly decorated State Apartments and St. George's Chapel, a pantheon of English monarchs.
- London is the largest city in Europe: quite a feat, considering its location on a relatively small island. London's location is perfect for an administrative, communications and trade center, as the Romans realized when they founded their city in AD 43. London is filled with countless historic and cultural treasures that meld seamlessly in this exciting, contemporary city.
- Our base for the next 8 nights will be in the greater London area. While here, breakfast and dinner will be included at the hotel restaurant.

 2017 will be the third time England plays host to the Federation of International Lacrosse
 (FIL) Women's Lacrosse World Cup. From humble beginnings, the World event started with
 just 4 nations competing for the title. England, Australia, Canada and America remain the
 most competitive teams in the tournament; however with the worldwide growth of lacrosse
 2017 will welcome 30 nations and the possibility of a change in status quo. The World Cup
 will feature 30 nations, 600 elite athletes, 15,000 spectators, 300 volunteers, 100 lacrosse
 officials. 100 festival teams.
- THE FEDERATION OF INTERNATIONAL LACROSSE
 The Federation of International Lacrosse has a vision for lacrosse to be played world-wide
 and achieve Olympic inclusion. Geographic development of Lacrosse has steadily increased
 over recent years. New lacrosse playing nations include Uganda and Israel. The Federation
 of International Lacrosse has recently been appointed as a member of SportAccord and
 included in the International World Games Association.
- OPENING CEREMONIES
 This evening we will attend the Opening Ceremonies of the Federation of International
 Lacrosse (FIL) Women's Lacrosse World Cup. The opening ceremonies are a celebration of
 lacrosse across the globe and will be a highlight of the week. The 30 nations will parade
 around the field proudly sporting their flag and colors, before the oaths and national anthems
 are sung.

We will see St. Paul's Cathedral, the Tower of London, Tower Bridge, Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Trafalgar Square, St. James's Park and Buckingham Palace, where we will see the Changing of the Guard ceremonies.
- Enjoy a Thames River Cruise, a relaxing way to view many of London's most magnificent sights. Our trip will take us past the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben and under the famous Tower Bridge.
- Visit the Tower of London, one of Britain's most fascinating and important historical structures. Begun as a fortress by William the Conqueror, the Tower is now primarily associated with the legendary figures imprisoned and executed here over the centuries. Our visit includes the armories, a display of instruments of torture and execution and the breathtaking Crown Jewels Exhibit.

- We will take an introductory Walking Tour of Oxford to view many of the beautiful and distinct colleges, as well as Bodleian Linrary and Radcliffe Camera.
- Visit Christ Church College, Oxford's largest and grandest Renaissance College, which was founded in 1525 by Cardinal Wolsey. The college's Christ Church Cathedral is the smallest in England. A highlight of our visit will be the dining room, the model for the dining room at Hogswart's in the Harry Potter films.

- Visit mysterious Stonehenge, a large circle of stone lintels and megalithic pillars, and one of the most impressive prehistoric monuments in Britain. Constructed approximately 5,000 years ago, Stonehenge symbolizes mystery, power and endurance.
- The charming city of Salisbury was founded in the 13th century after the settlement of Old Sarum was abandoned. The surrounding lush fields and rivers were a marked improvement over the former arid hill-top location. Today, Salisbury has largely preserved its medieval, Tudor and Queen Anne architecture, giving the city a delightful elegance.
- Visit Salisbury Cathedral, one of the finest medieval cathedral's in Britain. It is well-known for having the tallest spire in the country, which we may climb if we wish. Our visit will be highlighted by the cathedral's 13th century octagonal Chapter House, which displays the finest of four surviving original texts of the Magna Carta.
- We will have some free time for lunch and shopping in Salisbury.


