

## Referral Terms and Conditions

Referrals must be received online or by phone to receive the 15 Rewards Points. The Rewards Points will be awarded upon validation of the lead. To be a valid referral, you must have spoken with the teacher about WorldStrides prior to submitting their information. Referrals that already exist in the WorldStrides database and referrals from your school are not valid. Two or more referrals from the same school for the same program will qualify as one referral. No mailing or contact lists will be accepted.

Program Leaders must have qualified for the initial 15 Rewards Points level to be eligible to receive subsequent rewards benefits. Additional Rewards Points will be deposited into your Points account (1) once your referral has promoted a program in their school; (2) once your referral has completed travel on their first WorldStrides program; (3) only if the person who is referred leads that program; (4) if the referred teacher travels with a group of at least 5 full paying travelers within two years of being referred. You will receive 50 Rewards Points for the trip promotion and an additional 500 Rewards points upon completion of referral travel program.

WorldStrides complies with federal guidelines for reporting income to teachers. Program Leaders are responsible for knowing and complying with state laws and school policies regarding acceptance, disclosure, and use of financial rewards and prizes. WorldStrides reserves the right to substitute prizes of an equal or lesser value.
