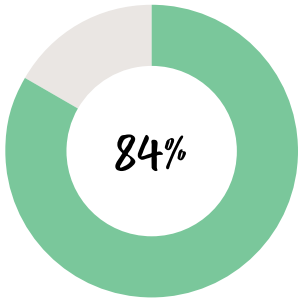
ON-SITE INTERNSHIPS

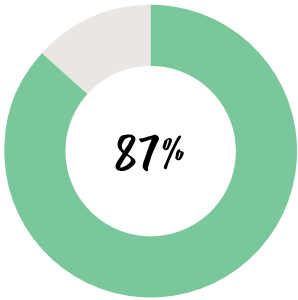
GLOBAL REMOTE INTERNSHIPS

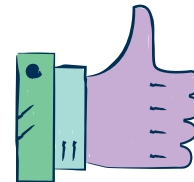
2. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION BY THE DEADLINE

Application deadlines vary. Be sure to check our chart on page 9 and set a calendar reminder if you need to. There are a handful of materials you'll need to submit, so you'll want to give yourself time.



3. PARTICIPATE IN AN ADVISING SESSION AND THE MATCHING PROCESS

Discuss resume/cover letter edits, goals for your internship, skills you bring, and your program expectations. Then, interview with a potential company (anywhere from 1 week after advising session to 10 weeks after advising session).



4. ACCEPT YOUR INTERNSHIP

- **Receive an internship offer:**
Accept your offer, pay your deposit, and book your airline ticket.
- **1 month before internship starts:**
Submit your final forms and payments.
- **3 weeks before internship starts:**
Participate in your pre-departure orientation.
- **2 weeks before internship starts:**
Receive your final packet with arrival information and housing assignments.
