DAY 1

Arrive in **Williamsburg, VA**

Meet your WorldStrides representative and begin your once-in-a-lifetime experience!

Jamestown Settlement (guided tour) View a replica of the original site where those three famous ships landed in 1607. You'll also see: Powhatan Indian Village, James Fort, Museum

Breakfast

Colonial Williamsburg Study Visit Explore the unique and rich history of 18th-century Williamsburg. In this living museum, participate in Revolutionary City, an interactive "street theatre," and visit Great Hopes Plantation, a "middling farm."

Colonial Williamsburg Study Visit (continued)

Governor's Palace The home to seven royal governors and the first two elected governors in Virginia.

Dinner

Evening Program ("In Defense of Liberty") Learn about the struggles of the Continental Army and discuss the role of women in the Army.

Return to hotel

DAY 3

Breakfast

Yorktown Victory Center Learn about life in Virginia during the Revolutionary War by exploring a Continental Army Encampment, galleries, and a farmstead.

Yorktown Battlefields: Surrender Field Visit the actual location of the British surrender to General Washington's army—probably the most decisive event of the American Revolution. Walk to Cornwallis' cave on the riverfront and through the town whose houses are still spotted with 18th-century musket balls.

Endview Plantation Visit with soldiers and civilians from Civil War Virginia.

Shirley Plantation The oldest of its kind in Virginia, this plantation is one of many that are situated along the historic James River.

***Evening Program** Early American Medical Practitioner or other historical program

Bacon's Castle Step back in time with a tour of this 17th-century architectural gem that was aptly named after the notorious Nathaniel Bacon and the rebellion he led.
