Breakfast and depart for Monterey Bay

Monterey Bay Aquarium Home to more than 623 species of plant and animal life, this interactive museum includes a collection of stingrays, jellyfish, sea otters, and even an 11-pound lobster that's more than 50 years old! Students will be challenged by their Course Leader to locate and observe a variety of different species and record their encounter with photos. Consider the challenges facing architects and engineers to create and maintain a seawater system for the animals and organisms in the aquarium.

Beach stop

Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park Walk between giants in this peaceful old-growth forest and wonder at the coastal redwoods, the oldest of which is at least 1,200 years old! Learn about how scientists examine trees and calculate their age. Hotel check-in and dinner

DAY 4 Breakfast **Exploratorium** At this world-famous interactive science museum, explore the more than 650 hands-on exhibits, which cover topics from the human body to outer space!

Alcatraz Island Learn about the significance of this historic location during cable the Civil War, and get familiar with the famed prison's transformation.

Pier 39 and Fisherman's Wharf Explore the sights and scenes of Pier 39, situated along the San Francisco Bay. Laugh with the sea lions, enjoy performance art and live drama, or take time to watch the beautiful hand-painted carousels.

Marine Mammal Center A scientific research center focusing on the rescue and rehabilitation of seals and sea lions. Learn how they treat the ill, injured or orphaned animals and return the healthy ones back to the wild.

Chinatown Visit the biggest Chinatown in the world!

Cable Car Ride Soak in the sights of the city as you ride one of San Francisco's historic cable cars. Explore the mechanics, engineering, and history behind this unique transportation and how cable cars managed the steep slopes of the city in an age of horse drawn wagons.
